1. Introduction
 - a. Attention of audience gained 5 pts.
 - b. Importance of subject established 5 pts.
 - c. Purpose clearly stated 5 pts.
2. Body
 - a. One central theme 5 pts.
 - b. Information accurate (source of information given) 5 pts.
 - c. Information current 5 pts.
 - d. Logical sequence 5 pts.
3. Summary
 - a. Major points emphasized 5 pts.

Delivery

4. Appearance
 - a. Grooming & dress 5 pts.
 - b. Poise & posture 5 pts.
5. Voice clear & understood 5 pts.
6. Appropriate vocal dynamics 5 pts.
7. Correct use of grammar 5 pts.
8. Eye contact with audience 5 pts.
9. Appropriate use of gestures & body language 5 pts.
10. Uniqueness of presentation 5 pts.
11. Audience appeal 5 pts.
12. Educational value 5 pts.
13. Questions
 - a. Accuracy of answers 5 pts.
 - b. Poise & self confidence 5 pts.
